Have you noticed the pink ribbons on the large group of trees lining the 9th fairway of the Lakes course? What does it mean for these trees? Well, ultimately it will lead to their demise. They will be felled to make way for the two-storey concrete driving range. These magnificent old growth trees will be reduced to ash if the

owners have their way...

We are reliably informed that an application will soon be presented to the Joint Development Assessment Panel (JDAP) for this concrete building, along with an application for a retirement village on the land where the current grass driving range is. The developers will most likely bypass the City of Swan in favour of going to the state, no doubt believing this is where they have a sympathetic ear and a smoother pathway. The City of Swan will be asked for their feedback. We, as residents, will also have the chance to present our feedback. This process can happen quite quickly, so we need to be on guard because it could happen any day now and we will need to act fast.

Any doubt you may have had about how serious the owners are to fulfil their vision should be quickly dismissed with the news that they have appointed an experienced consultant to oversee the development. Danny Murphy, former Executive Chairman with LWP, is that person.

We will be selling our 'The History of The Vines' book from The VRRA's tent for just \$10. These make a great stocking stuffer. See page 4 for more information on the book.






These QR Code posters will also be on display at the event which you can scan on the day.
